Humble Beginnings

Broens Industries is an Australian company, founded in 1979 and is now one of Australia's most modern tool rooms and high-tech manufacturing and engineering facilities.

Broens Industries was started by Carlos and Grace (Mimi) Broens on the 1st July 1979. It commenced operations providing subcontract toolmaking and general engineering services to a variety of clients. The Company moved into a single factory unit in Lyn Parade, Prestons on 1st January 1982 with 2 employees and commenced operations as a manufacturer of precision tooling, dies and general engineered products.

Early Expansion

The Company continued to grow and by 1986 occupied 3 units in the factory complex. Land was purchased at Ingleburn in August 1986 to build a new factory. The factory, on York Road, was occupied on 7th September 1987.

Growing Success

By 1993 the Company's workload made it necessary to build a larger facility and construction of a new factory and head office commenced. In January 1995 the Company moved into its new premises at 20 Williamson Road, Ingleburn. The new factory provided improved facilities for Tool and Die manufacture, CAD/CAM, EDM Wire machining and Research and Development.

In 2002 Broens Industries acquired Kirby Engineering, a designer and manufacturer of special purpose machining, assembly and testing equipment for the automotive industry.

To incorporate Kirby, Broens expanded its Williamson Road premises with the addition of plant number 2, a 6,000m² assembly and production facility.
